Re: Transervice Collective Agreement

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

I have received numerous enquiries regarding the Transervice Collective Agreement. Transervice has received a copy of the last Union proposal for changes and amendments to the previous Bell Craft Collective Agreement, however, Transervice did not agree with the changes proposed by the Union.

Therefore, as agreed in the Memorandum of Agreement signed in 2007, the Bell Craft Collective Agreement and the MOA now forms the Collective Agreement for our members at Transervice, until a new one is negotiated in 2012.

We have prepared a booklet that allows our locals and members to have a reference to the Collective Agreement. Too often we are hearing that the Employer is saying, "that is not covered in your agreement". This document is your Collective Agreement until such time one has been bargained and ratified by our members. Hard copies of the booklet will be mailed to all Locals in the near future.
