2011 NEGOTIATIONS WITH EXPERTECH FOR CEP CRAFT & SERVICES MEMBERS

October 27, 2011

Brothers and Sisters,

Your bargaining committee met the company again for a fourth week of negotiations. We made no significant progress. The gap between our demands and the company proposals is very wide.

Our objective is to bargain a good collective agreement and in the current state of negotiations we are nowhere near that goal.

Faced with this current state of affairs, we informed the company that we are asking the Minister of Labour to appoint a conciliator.

Under the Canada Labour Code, the Minister has 15 days following our request to appoint the conciliator. Negotiations will resume with the conciliator's assistance.

We remind you not to circulate rumours at work because they may undermine our efforts at the bargaining table.

We thank you for your continued support.
